## Aesthetics attracts theology

My conversation with the Japanese monk/ + y + y + z across the room: "Switzerland is a Catholic country, and within Switzerland there are Catholics, Protestants and Muslims. As an East Asian, I was confused about Chinese Buddhism, but in 1997 I had the opportunity to come to Switzerland to study Christianity by myself, and around 2004, through the stories of the Old Testament, I became interested in Christianity.

The Zhou dynasty (1046-256 BC) was the third slave state in Chinese history after the Shang dynasty, with 37 kings in 32 generations and a total of 790 years of rule. It was divided into two periods: the Western Zhou (1046-771 BC) and the Eastern Zhou (770-256 BC). The Zhou dynasty was founded by King Wu of the Zhou Dynasty, Ji Fa, and set its capital at Haojing (present-day Xi'an in Shaanxi). Because of its beauty, it lasted for eight hundred years, making it the longest dynasty in China.

My grandparents were a pair of Protestants who lived and worked in the top three medical Universität in the three towns of Wuhan, in the Wuchang area, and in 1994 my grandmother passed away in Wuchang without a trace, and a year and ten days later my grandfather passed away in Beijing. 2012 my grandparents gave me a dream that 1) they were together and 2) my grandmother and I spoke two or three words and I spoke two or three words to my grandmother. three words, with my grandfather listening, quietly, to my expressions from his relatively separate interior space, customarily in his dog-skin covered reclining chair. I couldn't guess then, what my grandmother was going to say to me, and what I could tell them.

In 2018 I joined a Protestant church, FEG Kriens / Horw, in the canton of Luzern, Switzerland, in the town of Horw, near my home. studied for over three years and completed my baptism. in January 2023 I resigned my membership in that church and returned to the Catholic Church.

Japanese Buddhism, for + y + y + y youself and for all of us, is the other side of the Buddhist definition: the atmospheric beauty of the soul body and the mysterious obsession of the spiritual body with the self, while Christianity (Catholic and Protestant) is the other side of the Buddhist definition, the autumnal shore: the struggle for power and those in power. What a

Japanese man can see, but cannot understand, is the logic of the upbringing and existence of a Swiss woman of Asian descent, of mixed Chinese and Swiss culture: we are born in different places, we work individually all our lives, we live out our lives, and in the end we sweep into our own hands just a little bit, that is life. My definition of Western religions: Judaism, Catholicism, Protestantism, Islam, Japanese Buddhism, Thai Buddhism.

Since the beginning of Human, there has been a constant quest for beauty. In Hinduism, people see the white cow as a deity of beauty, without daily labour. In Central Europe, sheep are kept, moreover, out of a sense of beauty. In the Christian birthday flower, there is an account of a young man tending sheep, as a patriotic saint. Beauty is incorporated into our lives to purify our souls and our bodies."
